

# Romans 6:11

Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord. KJV

Likewise, you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord. NKJV

In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. NIV

Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus. NEW AMERICAN STANDARD BIBLE

Even so consider yourselves also dead to sin and your relation to it broken, but alive to God [living in unbroken fellowship with Him] in Christ Jesus. AMPLIFIED

But living in fellowship with God through Christ Jesus.

But living for God as far as right doing is concerned.
